

ORDER DENYING RESPONDENTS' MOTION TO DISMISS

Having considered Respondents' Motion to Dismiss along with Memorandum in Support Thereof, and Complainants'/Petitioners' Response in Opposition to Motion to Dismiss, it is the decision of the State Higher Education Labor Relations Board (SHELRB, Board), that the facts set forth in the Complaint have sufficiently alleged a claim under the statute to proceed to an evidentiary hearing.
