Board Dismissal for Failure to State a Claim under Board Law or Regulations,
& Lack of Jurisdiction

On June 12, 2017, Petitioner Mercedes Exline filed an unfair labor practice complaint before the State Labor Relations Board (“Board”), pursuant to COMAR 14.32.05. In her complaint, Ms. Exline alleges that she was inappropriately held responsible for money missing from a cash drawer by Fred Salimi, owner of Park – N – Dine, and that Mr. Salimi had no proof of her making a mistake with the funds. Further, Ms. Exline states that Mr. Salimi withheld half of the money that was missing from the cash drawer from her most recent paycheck, and alleges that Mr. Salimi states that he plans to withhold the remaining half of the funds from Ms. Exline’s next paycheck. As remedy, Ms. Exline requests that the funds already withheld from her be returned, and that her next paycheck should not be subject to the withholding.

Ms. Exline’s complaint fails to demonstrate that Ms. Exline is an employee of any of the units of State government described in State Personnel & Pension Article §3-102(a). Accordingly, this complaint is dismissed.
